



Memorandum of Understanding
between Buriram Rajabhat University, Thailand
and
Mandalay University of Distance Education, The Republic of the Union of Myanmar

Buriram Rajabhat University, 349 Jira Road, Naimuang sub-district, Muang district, Buriram province, Thailand, and Mandalay University of Distance Education, Chanayetharzan Township, Mandalay, the Republic of the Union of Myanmar conclude the following Memorandum of Understanding to promote close cooperation and academic exchange between the two institutions.


- (1) Buriram Rajabhat University and Mandalay University of Distance Education agree to the following general framework of cooperation:
 - (i) Joint research and training activities;
 - (ii) Exchange of invitations extended to scholars for lectures, seminars and participation in conferences, colloquia and symposia;
 - (iii) Exchange of faculty and students for studies and research;
 - (iv) Exchange of information in fields of mutual interest;
 - (v) Cooperation in other areas will also be arranged through mutual agreement;
- (2) Research subjects of joint activities, conditions for utilizing research achievement, arrangements for mutual visits and exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated in each specific case.
- (3) Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements in each specific case depend on the availability of funds, which will be jointly and / or separately sought by Buriram Rajabhat University and Mandalay University of Distance Education. Any dispute, controversy and differences as to the interpretation and implementation of the MoU should be settled by mutual consultation between the parties.

- (4) This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either party giving six month notice to the other party in writing. The Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or extended by mutual written consent of the two parties. If, during the term of this Memorandum, a conflict or potential conflict of interest arises for one of the parties, then that party will immediately notify the other party in writing of that conflict or potential conflict of interest.

The parties here have satisfactorily examined and agreed to execute this Memorandum of Understanding by signing two copies in English.
